

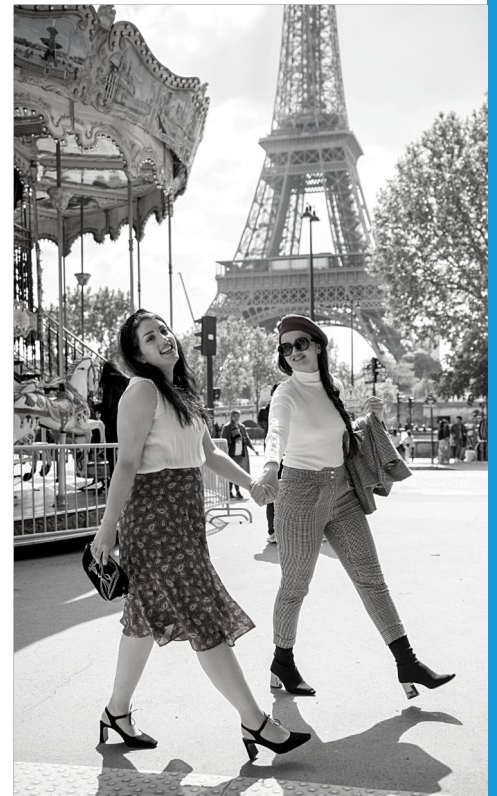

It is also composed of 4 extra hours of Action Learning during which students will be able to put their acquired knowledge into practice by working on a real life and cross boundary project.</p> <p>In addition, there will be 18 hours of activities, cultural visits in and around Paris that will allow students to get to know the Parisian culture and history better.</p>

Application procedure	Students do not need to be nominated by their home institutions. You can apply directly via PSB International Office by contacting us at international@psbedu.paris so that we can send you the online application link. Supporting documents will be uploaded on the application form.
Language requirements	<p>All students that are not enrolled in a higher education institution from an English-speaking country need to submit a proof of language. The following documents are accepted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Letter from your home institution showing that you have a B2 level in English• IELTS Academic: 6• Duolingo: 100• TOEFL iBT: 80• Cambridge: 170
Academic requirements	Students should have studied for at least one year in any program
Required documents for application	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Passport copy (attention to the expiry date!)• ID photo• Latest transcript of records• Proof of English level
Insurance requirements for incoming exchange students	<p>Before arrival, students must purchase a full health cover for the length of their stay.</p> <p>EU citizens do not need to purchase the health cover but must provide a copy of their European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). Non-EU citizens must purchase private insurance covering their whole period of stay in France.</p> <p>Students will have to submit a copy of their International Health Insurance to PSB IO the programme starts</p>
ECTS	7.5 ECTS (32 contact hours) + (18 hours of activities and cultural visits)
