

### Housing

Regarding the accommodation in Ribeirão Preto, FEA-RP/USP doesn't offer student accommodation in *Campus*, but we have a program with our Brazilian students in which they offer a place at their house / apartment to welcome an exchange student. The Brazilian students usually share a house or an apartment that are called "Repúblicas" and they are like fraternities. These accommodations are paid by the exchange student. We'll send more information later to all accepted ones. We have a group of students in our *Campus*, called iTeam USP-RP, which works and helps USP with international matters. iTeam USP-RP through its Housing Program helps international students find housing in Ribeirão Preto. All incoming students will be assisted by this program. After being accepted students will be placed in contact with the iTeam USP-RP, which will provide support.

Buddy Program – iTeam USP-RP also organizes the Buddy Program, which consists on FEA-RP students that are previously selected to be tutors of international students. The buddies assist students on their arrival in the city, present the school, giving all the support to help the stay.

### Meals on the campus

From R\$2.00 per meal (at the University restaurant, subsidized by the State of São Paulo) up to R\$30.00 per meal (at private restaurants and cafeterias on campus)

### **Health Insurance**

Students are required to purchase a health insurance in their home country before arriving in Brazil

#### **Books/study material**

Most of the course materials available at the university libraries for free

### Personal expenses

We estimate an approximately expense of R\$1000,00 per month (including housing and meals)
