APPLICATION PROCESS FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS <i>Email will be sent for each step</i>	Official Nomination sent by partner university (Name + First name of the students + Period of study + Email address+ Date of birth) STEP 1: Students will get a Login & Password to register online and will have to send us by email an official ID jpg picture (deadline fall: May 1 st / spring: November 1 st) STEP 2: Housing application (fall: mid-May mid-June / spring: mid-November mid-December) STEP 3: French test online (fall: June / spring: November) STEP 4: Courses selection online (fall: July/ spring: December) STEP 5: emergency contact details must be completed upon arrival.
STUDY PROGRAMME <i>Courses catalogue online</i>	ESCE MASTER (Five Year Degree) Undergraduate and graduate courses For fall: Exchange students can select courses from the 2 nd or 3 rd or 4 th and 5 th year if pre-requisites. (For 5 th year classes, it is mandatory to send transcripts). For spring: Exchange students can select courses from the 2 nd or 4 th year + international courses. Student will need to select a major (2 core courses+ 4 courses from the <u>same</u> specialization) Majors: -International Marketing -Finance -Entrepreneurship -International People Management - Supply Chain management -Export management -Wellbeing at work 30 ECTS per semester (maximum) and 15 ECTS (minimum) Courses are offered in French and/or in English
LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION	French and/or English Language requirements : no official test required but level B2 expected to study business courses in French or in English

LANGUAGE COURSE	French Language course mandatory for all exchange students (no charge/free): beginner, intermediate and advance level No beginner language course offered in other languages like Spanish, German, Italian, and Portuguese...

WORK PLACEMENT	Work placement/Internship possible after a minimum of one semester of study at ESCE only if placement/internship is part of the study at the home institution and mandatory in the curriculum.
HOUSING	Halls of residence: Step 2 from June 1 st Contact person Jennifer KRAUS jennifer.kraus@esce.fr Residences located around Paris: Rent 650 – 950€ per month (single room), Deposit (one month rent) and reservation fee should be paid by bank transfer to book the room Most of the studios are single rooms ONLY! (No roommate) with private bathroom and kitchen. Some residences require payment in advance of the total of your rent!
HEALTH INSURANCE	EU Students: European Card, copy to give upon arrival! NON EU Students: French Health insurance mandatory (215€ to pay before arriving at ESCE by bank transfer) for one semester or one academic year. Price subject to change. The fee is not refundable.
VISA	An invitation letter will be sent to Non EU students to start visa application with Campus France or French consulate. NON EU students coming from an European university: Visa is mandatory because European residence card ONLY allows students to visit France during 90 days but not to study in France.
